Poster Competition Information & Guidelines

- 1. Artists must be in grades 1 5 and *each school* may enter as many as they would like.
- 2. Posters must be original work & include a title.
- 3. Posters must be no smaller than 8 ½" x 11" and no larger than 11" x 17". <u>Posters outside of these parameters will be disqualified.</u>
- 4. Posters will be judged on the following criteria:
 - 1. Creativity
 - 2. Artistic skill
 - 3. How well the artwork represents the ideals of wildlife conservation
- 5. Any medium may be used (crayons, watercolor, colored pens, pencils, oils, acrylic, etc.). Please refrain from using materials that may smear, crack, or chip.
- 6. Posters will be mounted and matted by SEWE. <u>Posters that are already matted.</u> mounted, or framed will be disqualified.
- 7. Students must attach one copy of the entry form to the back of the poster. *Teachers must email an Excel spreadsheet* (example included) containing the students information.
- 8. Posters are due by 5:00 p.m. on **Monday, December 11th, 2023**, and should be hand delivered to the SEWE office, 211 Meeting Street, 2nd Floor, Charleston, SC 29401 or mailed to PO Box 20635, Charleston, SC 29413. (**Do not mail posters to physical address!**)
- 9. Photographs of students holding their work may be emailed to hshannon@sewe.com for promotional use. This is not required.
- 10. Posters will be on display in the Main Branch of the Charleston County Public Library (68 Calhoun Street) during the month of February.
- 11. Winners will be announced the week of December 13th and prizes will be mailed to teachers early-January.
- 12. Posters will be picked up from the library by the SEWE staff and mailed along to the school (to the teacher's attention) in early March. SEWE nor the Library will be responsible for any lost or damaged artwork.

Photography & Poetry Information and Guidelines

- 1. Students must be in grades 6 8.
- 2. Each student may submit one photograph or one poem. Each school may submit as many entries as they would like.
- 3. All submissions must be original work and have a title.
- 4. Subject matter must relate to nature, wildlife or conservation.
- 5. Entries may be no larger than 11" x 14".
- 6. Entries will be judged on the following criteria:
 - 1. Creativity
 - 2. Relevance to nature, wildlife and conservation
 - 3. Quality of photograph
- 7. Entries must be submitted in hard copy. Digital versions may be emailed *in addition* to hshannon@sewe.com. Color of photograph is at the discretion of photographer.
- 8. Students must attach one copy of the entry form to the back of the entry. Teachers must email an Excel spreadsheet (example included) containing the students information to hshannon@sewe.com.
- 9. Entries are due by 5:00 p.m. on **Monday, December 11th, 2023**, and should be hand delivered to the SEWE office, 211 Meeting Street, 2nd Floor, Charleston, SC 29401 or mailed to PO Box 20635, Charleston, SC 29413. **(Do not mail posters to physical address!)**
- 10. Entries submitted may be printed in SEWE publications, website, and local media.
 - 11. Winners will be announced the week of December 13th and prizes will be mailed to teachers mid-December.

Birdhouse Competition

Information & Guidelines

- 1. The artist must be in grades 9 12.
- 2. <u>Student's name, school and title of project must be written on each birdhouse. Please use a permanent marker and write on the bottom of the birdhouse</u>
- 3. Birdhouses must have a visible title. Birdhouses without a title will be disqualified.
- 4. Teachers, please submit one copy of each student's form to the front desk of the library. Have all forms in a folder labeled with your school's name.
- 5. Teachers must email an Excel spreadsheet (example included) containing the student's information to hshannon@sewe.com.
- 6. All birdhouses must be built primarily from natural material and/or recyclable goods.
- 7. The birdhouses will be judged on the following criteria:
 - 1. Creativity
 - 2. Craftsmanship
 - 3. Type of material used for building
 - 4. Wildlife Related
- 8. All entries should be portable (by one person) and able to stand alone on a display table.
- 9. Birdhouses should be dropped off at the Charleston County Public Library, Main Branch (68 Calhoun Street, Charleston, SC) between **Friday, January 26**th **and Monday, January 29**th, **2024.**
- 10. A high-res image of each Birdhouse should be emailed to Hannah Shannon at hshannon@sewe.com by 5:00p.m. on Monday, January 29th, 2024. The image files should be named in the following format: "Student Last Name, Student First Name_Entry Title_School". Please also send the competition entry form so that information can be properly matched with the images.
- 11. The winners of the Birdhouse Competition will be announced the week of February 1st, 2024 and prizes will be mailed to teachers on February 2nd, 2024.
- 12. Birdhouses should be picked up **between Friday, March 1st and Monday, March 4th**. *SEWE nor the Library will be responsible for any lost or damaged artwork.*
